



SHOW & SHINE

Judging:

- Judges cannot vote for their own vehicle or one that they have helped prepare.
- Judges can vote for another Judge's vehicle.
- In the event of a tie the vehicle with the most first place choices will win.
- In the event of a further tie the Origine RS Team's decision is final.
- Cars should be judged on overall presentation on the day. Whether a car is awarded a higher or lower position due to originality is left to the individual Judges discretion.

Competition cars:

- Any car fitted with a roll cage, competition seats and harnesses prepared to a recognised standard.
- Any car which in the Judges' opinion is best suited to this category.

Modern (or Modified)

- Any car less than 10 years old.
- Any car which is substantially modified from the manufacturer's original specification and does not fit into one of the other categories.
- Cars should be judged on the overall impact, success and integration of the modifications. Whether a car is awarded a higher or lower position due to the modifications having being carried out by the owner themselves or a specialist garage/professional is left to the individual Judge's discretion.

Categories:

1. Best Modern Car
2. Best Alpine
3. Best V6 Clio
4. Best Competition Car
5. Best Renaultsport
6. Best Classic Car
7. Best Turbo Renault
8. Best in Show

'Star' or invited cars can be included if they are appropriate for one of the above categories.

A category may be deleted if there are insufficient eligible cars present to award a Winner and/or Runner up.
