



RAOC Origine RS Autotests : Final Instructions, Part 1, Brooklands – 30th September 2017.

Read this carefully

Thank you for your entry, these Part 1 Final Instructions are to help you prepare for the event. At the event, you'll receive all the remaining paperwork, including competition numbers, and the Part 2 Final Instructions. There is a current entry list attached, If you see any mistakes on Entry List or have any questions, please contact Simon Taylor, details below. There is likely to be other drivers entering on the day to boost participants.

• The Venue

Remember that the Brooklands site is a Public venue. This means that there will be members of the public and their families present who are nothing to do with Origine RS and just visiting the site as a paying member of the public. We **MUST** all respect the site Rules & Regulations and behave in a way that does not bring the Clubs or Motorsport into disrepute.

SITE SPEED LIMIT IS STRICTLY 5mph WHEN NOT ON THE AUTOTEST COURSES.

• Vehicle paperwork:

Remember, If you have completed an electronic entry form you can skip this Paperwork.

Otherwise, for “signing-on” please remember to bring all the following:

- **Proof that your car is taxed:** www.gov.uk/check-vehicle-tax

- **A current insurance certificate or cover note**

- **A current MOT certificate, if the car is more than 3 years old**

- **Your current club membership card, or join RAOC on the day (£20 for a year)**

• Timetable, on arrival

Parking

Competing cars **MUST** park as directed in the paddock area, which is near the foot of the Hill.
non-competing cars must park in the areas away from the competing cars.

Signing-on and scrutineering will start from 10.00 am

Recommended arrival is by 10.30am.

Exclusion may apply, if you have not arrived by 11.00

- **On arrival, first sign on at the Club Gazebo**, to get your competitor's pack

- Put your numbers on the car door or inside the rear window

- Get your car scrutineered

- You can then walk the hill and course, before **a drivers' briefing at 11.15.**

• Noise

Noise and environmental control are a key challenge for Motor Sport venues and events these days. **All cars must be silenced to acceptable road going limits.** **ANY** car deemed too noisy by the event officials will be asked to retire immediately. Please refrain from any unnecessary tyre noise at any time when on the site, even when on the courses. There will be no tyre warming on-site. The Club and the Sport cannot afford for noise complaints to be received which could jeopardise the venue or the club from running future events.

The event organisers decision will be final and without question.

- **Car preparation**

Special preparation isn't required, beyond basic safety checks, ensuring no loose objects in the car or the boot, and that nothing's loose or leaking under the bonnet. In dry conditions, an extra 5 to 10 psi of tyre pressure will reduce tyre flexing, and sharpen up the steering response. Have the oil level at Maximum, to minimise any chance of oil surge (oil pressure loss) when cornering.

- **Tyre wear**

Tyre wear can occur at AutotestsSolos, particularly if it's dry, if a car is front wheel drive (when wear is mainly on the front tyres), has two drivers or is driven very hard. To ensure you can drive home legally, do arrive with good tread showing. If more than one of the above applies, we advise bringing at least two spare wheels, either fit them to compete or have them in reserve to use for driving home. So long as you arrive with good tyres you should not expect this to be a problem for you or your car.

- **Facilities**

We will have shared use with the general public of the Brooklands Museum Café and Restaurant. They are open all day for Breakfast, Lunch, cakes and Drinks. Hot food at Lunch time is only served between 12-00 and 14-30. The Museum also has full toilet facilities.

- **Photos**

Photos from the event may appear on the Origine RS, RAOC, FDMC websites and on the websites of photographers. If this could cause any embarrassment, remove or cover your number plates.

- **Directions**

Directions are on the Brooklands website and will have been sent to you with your Origine RS tickets etc. On entering the site please park in the Paddock area.
