Held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations

1. The Renault Alpine Owners Club will organise a Clubmans Permit Autotest at Brooklands Museum, Weybridge, Surrey, KT13 0QN on Saturday 30 September 2017.
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association, available from www.msauk.org/assets/bluebook2017completevlow-res.pdf and incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
3. Motor Sports Association Permit No. – 103443 Taster Event
4. The event is open to all current members of Renault Alpine Owners Club, Farnborough District Motor Club and any other MSA affiliated clubs that have accepted an invitation from the organisers, and will be listed in the final instructions. RAOC will be offering Day membership on the Entry Form.
5. The provisional outline of the event will be as follows;

Saturday 30th September 2017.

- 10-00 hrs Event and Venue Opens
 - 10-00 hrs – 11-00 hrs Signing-on & Scrutineering
 - 11-15 hrs Drivers Briefing
 - 11-30 hrs – 14-00hrs Driving Autotests
 - 16-00 hrs approx Awards Presentation
 - confirmation of the exact timetable will be detailed in the Competitors' Final Instructions which should be published by email about 5 days before the event.
6. The competition will consist of a maximum of 3 Driving Test courses. Each Driver will have a maximum of 3 attempts at each Course. The best time from each test will count towards the final position and awards. The test diagrams will be issued at signing-on for the event.
 7. Cars ;

- Will be presented in a clean and good mechanical condition
 - Will NOT have any loose items on board
 - Will not be leaking any fluids
 - Will have a well secured battery
 - Open Cars may be run with roof up or down, and with Hardtop fitted or not.
8. Drivers ;
- Will not carry Passengers.
 - Will wear a seat belt
 - Must have a current valid RTA (Driving Licence) Licence appropriate to the vehicle being driven (and hence will be over 16 years old).
9. The AutoTests will be timed to an accuracy of at least 1/10th second. Penalties will be applied, in seconds, as follows:

No.	Action – Per infringement	Penalty
1	For hitting or touching a board(s) or any marker	10
2	For any wheel touching the grass on tests where it is stated that the “grass penalty applies”	10
3	For not stopping in the correct place	10
4	Failing to stop astride finish line facing forward	10
5	Following wrong route	BIC+20
6	Failing to complete test	BIC+20
7	Not pulling forward to the start line when requested to do so by a marshal	30
8	Not driving a Car with Renault power	10
9	Not having a valid Car Club Sticker on your car	10
10	Not dressed in attire complimenting your car	10

(BIC = Best in Class)

10. Once the Start Marshal has confirmed to the Competitor that the course is clear, Competitors will be permitted to start tests ‘in their own time’, with timing starting from the moment the front axle crosses the start line.
11. The event will consist of 4 classes for advance entries:
- Class 1 Historic Cars, (Car first registered Pre-1980, takes precedence over 2 & 3)
 - Class 2 Front engine cars (registered after 1980)
 - Class 3 Rear engine Cars (registered after 1980)
 - Class 4 Specials
- Classes 1, 2 and 3 are for road-going road legal cars driven to the event venue. Specials are competition cars, 4WD, Renault Powered car (eg Delorean etc)
12. Awards will be presented to the advance entry competitor with the best overall performance, subject to a minimum of 3 Competitors per Class. No Competitor shall win more than 1 award. There will be additional awards for 2nd in class (subject to a min 4 entries in class) and a 3rd in class (subject to a min 8 entries in class).
- Fastest Time of Day

- Fastest Historic Car (Pre-1980)
 - Fastest Front engined Car
 - Fastest Rear engined Car
 - Fastest Special Car
 - Fastest Lady Driver
13. The entry fee is £30 payable in advance
- RAOC Day membership is additional £5.
 - New members, promotional Annual membership, additional £20.
 - Cars maybe “shared” and entered by up to 3 separate competitors, where each driver will complete a separate entry form and entry fee.
 - Drivers may enter up to 2 cars, which shall not be in same class.
14. The maximum entries will be 40 and the minimum will be 12.
- Entries will be taken and recoded on a fist come basis.
 - A reserve list will operate when 40 is reached.
 - An entry MUST be made via official On-Line Entry page, Entry Form & Entry Fee.
 - Organisers may amalgamate classes where less than 3 Competitors are in a class.
 - Should minimum number of entries not be reached organisers may take the option to postpone the Autotests and full refunds will be provided.
15. Closing date will be midnight on Tuesday 26th September.
16. Competitors Cars will be identified with Numbers, supplied by the organisers.
- Some of the marker cones may be less than 1 metre high.
 - Marshals in charge of tests are appointed judges of fact for the purposes of determining whether or not a competitor has performed the test correctly.
17. Any appeal or protest must be lodged by completing an official Protest form, available from the Secretary of the Meeting.
